Application Notes

This Human Transmembrane protein 163 (TMEM163) ELISA Kit employs a two-site sandwich ELISA to quantitate TMEM163 in samples. An antibody specific for TMEM163 has been pre-coated onto a microplate. Standards and samples are pipetted into the wells and any TMEM163 present is bound by the immobilized antibody. After removing any unbound substances, a biotin-conjugated antibody specific for TMEM163 is added to the wells. After washing, Streptavidin conjugated Horseradish Peroxidase (HRP) is added to the wells. Following a wash to remove any unbound avidin-enzyme reagent, a substrate solution is added to the wells and color develops in proportion to the amount of TMEM163 bound in the initial step. The color development is stopped and the intensity of the color is measured.
